La Banquise, originally a small ice-cream shop, first opened its doors in May 1968. The following fall, its founder and local fireman Pierre Barsalou, decided to transform the enterprise into a 24-hour snack bar. At the time La Banquise specialized in amazing good hot-dogs and legendary fries.


Poutine first appeared on the menu at the start of the 1980's. Originally, Classic and Italian were the only two varieties offered. In response to repeated requests and very satisfied customers, the restaurant's poutine choices quickly multiplied. Today, we offer no less than 30 different types of poutine.

To this day, La Banquise remains a family business. Mr. Barsalou's youngest daughter Annie took over in the 90s along with her partner Marc Latendresse. Together, they carry on the tradition of quality and maintain the excellent reputation of La Banquise.

In the summer of 2006, La Banquise underwent major renovations and a much larger dining area was created. Fifty years on, La Banquise represents much more than a simple snack bar or poutine joint. It is also a warm and friendly venue where customers can enjoy an extensive choice of microbrewery beers, daily menu and outstanding breakfasts.



In 1929, a small horse's carriage was all the space needed to perfect this classic Montreal hot dog. Each day, Ma Tante Marguerite and her husband would park themselves in Montréal-Nord and serve the community.

As word spread about the deliciousness of the food and the kind service, the happy couple upgraded their operation to a campervan. After swapping the vehicle's interior for kitchen appliances, the van's windows were repurposed for handing-off hot dogs with a smile.

Ma Tante's legacy soon outgrew the van. In 1950, she literally cemented herself in the lives of many Montrealers by building her restaurant, and on top of it, her home. While Marguerite can no longer be found there, her legacy lives on, her smile is still warming, and her hot dogs are always salivating!

Schwartz's Deli

World Famous Original Smoked Meat! by TAYLOR GELLER on NOVEMBER 19TH, 2019

Over 90 years of tradition. The oldest deliin Canada. Atrue Montreal landmark situated on the historic "Main". It was established on December 31, 1928 by Reuben Schwartz, a Jewish immigrant from Romania. Its long popularity has led to it being considered a cultural institution of Montreal.

Schwartz's signature dish is a smoked meat sandwich served on rye bread with yellow mustard. The meat is served by the fat content: lean, medium, medium-fat or fat. Medium and medium-fat are the most popular. According to journalist Bill Brownstein, the classic Schwartz's meal includes a medium-fat sandwich, fries, half-sour pickle, coleslaw, red pepper, and a black cherry soda.





Schwartz's has also been the subject of numerous articles in Canadian and international publications. The restaurant has been the subject of two documentary films.

PIKNIC ELECTRONIK

Piknic Électronik Montreal is an outdoor electronic music event aiming to offer immersive, social experiences in a friendly environment. Located in an urban park just 10 minutes from downtown Montréal, he brings together thousands of electronic music enthusiasts every Sunday from May to September. Piknic Électronik Montreal diverse programing has made it a highlight of the Montreal summer cultural circuit for over 15 years. This summer, Piknic is back with 21 events on the calendar from May 17th to September 27th, 2020.

The Piknic concept has expanded beyond Montréal's borders. In 2012, the first Piknic Électronik kicked off in Barcelona, followed by Melbourne and Dubai in 2014 and Santiago Chile in 2015 and Paris in 2019.
